The NZEI Te Riu Roa has advised the Te Uku Board of Trustees that the principal and teachers at our school will be taking strike action on Wednesday, 15 August 2018, for the entire school day. Therefore, the school will be closed for instruction due to strike action. The Board has carefully considered the availability of teaching staff and have unfortunately decided that we cannot provide the normal teaching and supervision services during the strike. It is important that you make alternative arrangements for the care of your child/children on the day of the strike. **Late Collection of Students**

Parents arriving late to collect their children in the afternoon has become an increasing problem. 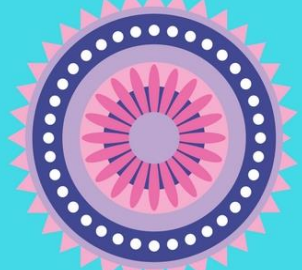
