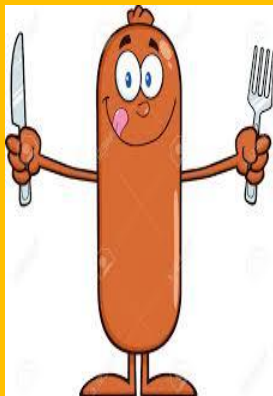
Tēnā koutou e te whānau o Te Uku
